This Term Theme: Knowing Right from Wrong

Our focus book this half term is Supertato by Sue Hendra and Paul Linnet. This is a great

story about a superhero who must keep the supermarket safe from an Evil Pea.

In English we will be writing character descriptions based on our focus book. We will also be retelling the story. Each day we will continue to have daily phonics lessons.

In Maths we will be looking at the value of numbers within 10 and strategies for addition and subtraction.

Our Science will focus on is animals including humans. We will learn about the parts of the human body and how these are associated with different senses.

In RE we will be thinking about what Christian's believe about God.

In Geography we will focus on maps and aerial photography. We will be creating our own maps based on our school and the local environment. Our history will focus on Goose Fair and how this event started and has changed over time.

In Computing sessions, we are going to be talking more about how we use technology and ways that we can do this safely.

- 2) Encourage them to use My Maths, sing counting songs and rhymes.
- 3) Help your child continue to learn their times tables, using Times Table Rock Stars (TTRS)

 - Spelling lists are on Spelling Shed. Please help your child practice these as it really helps them become more confident with their reading and writing.
 - Phonics play, also has lots of fun games for children to enjoy.
