Please remember to come to school in your PE kit including suitable footwear such as trainers in case we are outside.

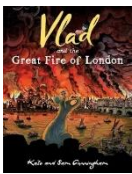
(Plain T-shirt, plain Joggers and school cardigan/jumper).

In English we will be writing a recipe and a diary, inspired by this book.

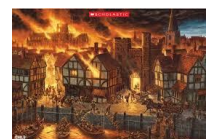
In Maths we will continue to develop our fluency skills alongside other areas of the maths curriculum.

What can you do to support your child's learning?
