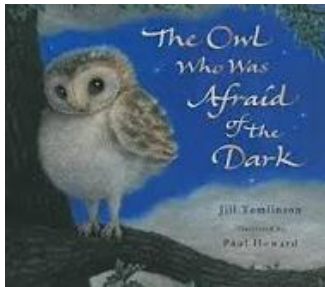

This half term the children will be reading *The Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark* and *After the Storm*. Alongside these stories, they will explore a range of non-fiction books linked to woodland animals.



In English we will be re-writing the story of *The Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark* and creating our own woodland animal fact files.

In Maths, we will be exploring geometry through position and direction before reviewing and consolidating our understanding of the four operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

In Science, we will be continuing our learning about animals, including humans.

In RE we will be learning about Christianity, with a focus on friendship.

We will be comparing the climate in Nottingham to regions in Africa.

In Art we will be using different painting techniques to create animal prints and textures.
